DESCRIPTION:	This course provides Navy military and civilian workers and supervisors involved in asbestos removal operations with EPA-accredited training on asbestos regulations, inspecting and reporting of asbestos hazards, and managing removal operations. Graduates will receive a one-year EPA certification as “Supervisor”. This course meets all requirements established by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act(ASHARA), National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants standards, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Transportation (DOT).
ELIGIBILITY:	Navy military and civilian personnel who may be assigned or required to perform or supervise all classes of asbestos removal operations. Due to the intensity of the course, strongly recommended military personnel not stand duty while attending this course.
