<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	The course is designed to provide military and civilian personnel serving as Respiratory Protection Program managers(RPPM's) and Assistant or Alternate RPPM's at shore commands, and Respiratory Protection Officers(RPO's) and Assistant/Alternate RPO's on CV's, CVN's, AS's, AOE's, LHD's, LHA's, and LPH's, with the training necessary to effectively establish, maintain and monitor respiratory protection programs within their commands/activities. The course is also designed to provide Industrial Hygienists and Industrial Hygiene Officers with the training to effectively evaluate and inspect activity respiratory protection programs during industrial hygiene surveys.
<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	Must be in GS-018 classification series or military personnel with assigned duty as the command/activity RPPM/ARPPM or RPO/ARPO (on CV's, CVN's, AOE's, LHD's, LHA's or LPH's); or in the GS-690 classification series or Industrial Hygiene Officer.
